Victor Harbor Dolphin Watch ...

Began in 2011 with SA Whale Centre volunteers and Investigator College students. Operating collaboratively with Kangaroo Island Dolphin Watch with NRM Community Grant funding, it has achieved extraordinary outcomes through successful regional cooperation.

Through involvement and support of "Fleurieu Marine Life", a site-based network undertaking regular observations, underpinning boat-based field surveys has been established. It will yield much needed data regarding frequency and range of movements and connectivity.

As dolphins in the region are at risk due to human impact and intensive boating activity, development of public awareness and community education is an imperative.
